

## CHAMPAGNE

- VEUVE CLICQUOT N.V** **£39.80**  
A medium dry, full bodied Champagne that is rich in fruit with good body & length. At its best it is a rich, full, fruity wine.
- TAITTINGER Brut Reserve N.V** **£36.30**  
Dry medium bodied showing a chardonnay richness, superb balance & intensity of flavour only achieved by long maturity from a top house.
- BILLECART-SALMON Brut Reserve N.V** **£29.80**  
Fine bubbles which rise slowly, persistent mousse, a nose of ripe pear with some touches of cut hay.
- BOLLINGER N.V** **£39.10**  
A bone dry, full bodied Champagne that is crisp and fresh and has a good mature flavour.
- TAITTINGER Vintage 2003** **£45.70**  
Dry, medium bodied yet, extremely elegant and rich, showing hints of brioche and chocolate on the finish.
- KRUG GRAND CUVEE N.V** **£124.00**  
Undoubtedly one of the finest Champagnes in the World. Extremely rich and full bodied with opulent honeyed fruit flavours.
- CANARD-DUCHENE N.V** **£26.00**  
An old house revived by the expertise of Veuve Clicquot in 1978. Resulting in this elegant, medium bodied champagne of great finesse and character.
- BILLECART-SALMON Brut Rose N.V** **£44.90**  
Delicate fruit on the palate, elegant and showing great finesse. A nose of red fruits and fresh pear.

## WHITE WINE

### FRANCE :

### BURGUNDY

- MACON-VILLAGES, Louis Jadot, 2007** £11.80  
A fresh, clean and fruity style with subtle green apple and pear flavours and plenty of minerals.
- CHABLIS Vieilles Vignes, Domaine Vocoret 2007 / 2008** £15.70  
From an acclaimed producer of Chablis, this is a great example of this style of Chardonnay having lovely depth of fruit and mineral complexity.
- CHABLIS 1er Cru, Vieilles Vignes, Domaine Vocoret, 2006 / 2007** £18.80  
Made from old vines for added complexity, this has a fresh steely dryness, crisp citrus and ripe orchard fruits.
- MONTAGNY 1er Cru 2006/07, Château de Cray** £14.60  
A delicious dry wine with buttery rich Chardonnay flavours. The combination of fresh lemony flavours and balanced acidity result in a complex elegant wine.
- POUILLY-FUISSE, Vieilles Vignes 2007, Domaine Cordier** £23.70  
This is a wine of sheer elegance with complex fruit flavours and a long lingering finish.
- MEURSAULT, 2006/07 , Bourguignon** £25.00  
Deliciously complex, showing a fine bouquet of hazelnut, toast and honey with a full bodied mouth of citrus fruits.
- MEURSAULT 1<sup>er</sup> Cru, 2004, Château de Blagny, Louis Latour** £28.80  
This beautifully crafted wine distinguishes itself with ripe and nutty buttered fruits, crisp lemon acidity, lush texture and well integrated oak.
- CHABLIS GRAND CRU, 2006/2007 , Vocoret** £32.00  
Blanchots produces wines that are amongst the most delicate, perfumed and stylish of all The Grand Cru Chablis.
- CHASSAGNE MONTRACHET 1<sup>er</sup> Cru, 2006 'La Maltroie, Fontaine Gagnard** £37.60  
Aromas of pears mingle with the rounder flavours of buttered toast and vanilla on the rich, opulent palate.
- CORTON CHARLEMAGNE 2004, Louis Latour** £52.10  
A complex nose of buttered corn, grilled nuts, white peach and vanilla. The palate is dense, rich and multi-layered with lovely harmony between fruit, structure and oak.

**FRANCE Cont :****LOIRE****- SANCERRE, Domaine Vacheron 2007/2008** **£21.30**

Fabulously aromatic nose, concentrated gooseberry fruit flavours, all carefully balanced by a rich smokiness. Sancerre at its most elegant.

**- POUILLY FUME Domaine des Rabichattes 2007/08, Grebet** **£14.10**

Fruity undercurrent of Gooseberries, culminating in a crisp balanced finish.

**SPAIN :****- RUEDA BLANCO 2007/2008, Marqués de Riscal** **£ 9.90**

A light, delicate wine with an intensely aromatic bouquet, bursting with fruit. The acidity is well balanced to give a crisp finish.

**NEW ZEALAND :****- OYSTER BAY SAUVIGNON 2008** **£10.90**

A wine of international acclaim, penetrating citrus flavours integrated with fresh herbs giving a very fresh style of wine.

**SOUTH AFRICA :****- BOSCHENDAL, Sauvignon Blanc, 2008, Coastal region** **£11.30**

Tropical fruit, citrus and herbs on the nose, crisp acidity and a clean lingering finish.

**CHILEAN****- SANTA RITA Reserva, Sauvignon 2008, Casablanca Valley** **£9.40**

From a leading producer, this is a stylish invigoratingly rich and zesty Sauvignon with a floral, elderflower bouquet and tropical fruits in abundance.

**AUSTRALIA :****- Yalumba Y Series Viognier 2007/08, South Australia** **£9.40**

This is a full-bodied dry white wine with a gorgeously perfumed scent and a ripe, peachy fruitiness.

**- VASSE FELIX Chardonnay 2007, Margaret River** **£14.10**

A full bodied style displaying richness and packed with ripe tropical fruits, combined with fresh, well balanced acidity.

## RED WINE

FRANCE :

### BORDEAUX

- CHATEAU DU MONTHYL 2003, Medoc** **£10.90**  
A nose of ripe and stewed fruits and hints of cedar and almonds with a well balanced palate of red fruits and well integrated tannins.
- CHATEAU CALON, 2001, Montagne St Emilion** **£16.60**  
An elegant Claret with toasted notes and mature red fruit flavours. Medium bodied with classically fine, elegant and silky tannins.
- CHATEAU CARONNE Ste Gemme 2003/04, Cru Bourgeois, Haut-Medoc** **£17.20**  
Slightly smoky on the palate with ripe fruits, black pepper and subtle oak giving a well rounded finish.
- CHATEAU LA ROUCHONNE, 2006, St Emilion Grand Cru** **£15.60**  
With a nose of raspberry, dried herbs, vanilla and wood smoke, this has a rich multi-layered texture.
- LA RESERVE DE LEOVILLE-BARTON 2004, St Julien** **£27.50**  
Deep, seductive colour with an attractive, harmonious bouquet of dried fruit, mint and spices.
- CHATEAU SENEJAC, 2002, Cru Bourgeois, Haut Medoc** **£19.30**  
Deep coloured and heavily perfumed, this has exceptional balance and freshness with flavours of blackcurrant and cedar notes.
- CHATEAU BEAU-SITE, 2003, St Estephe, Cru Bourgeois** **£23.20**  
Aromas of blackberry, smoke and spices, this is full-bodied, with thick silky tannins and a flavourful finish.
- CHATEAU LALANDE BORIE, 2004, St Julien** **£25.00**  
A full bodied wine opulent with savoury fruit flavours and well balanced tannins creating real elegance typical of St Julien.
- CHATEAU BATAILLEY 2002, 5ème Cru Classé, Pauillac** **£35.30**  
Deep ruby colour with elegant blackcurrant and truffle flavours, notes of cigar box, pepper and spices.
- CHATEAU TALBOT, 2000, St Julien, 4eme Cru Classé** **£78.00**  
A layered texture, sweet tannins, herbaceous leather aromas and licorice infused blackcurrant flavours typify this elegant, powerful wine.

## BURGUNDY

- GEVREY CHAMBERTIN 1999, Louis Chavy** £18.20  
This wine is medium-bodied and delicate with enticing berry fruit flavours and good balance and shows off its maturity with subtle gamey and earthy flavours.
- SAVIGNY 1<sup>er</sup> Cru, 'La Bataillere aux Vergelesses', 2005, Albert Morot** £25.10  
This wine displays subtly spicy, earthy fruit aromas of red berries and fruits of the forest and discreet spice.
- NUITS-SAINT-GEORGES, 2005 / 2006, Arnoux & Lachaux** £29.60  
Generous aromas of cherries, dark fruits and spices. The palate is intense and lush with black and redcurrant fruit and a long finish.
- GIVRY 1<sup>er</sup> Cru Vieilles Vignes 2005 / 2006, Michel Sarrazin** £18.00  
Bright red in colour, aromas of red berry fruits continue on the concentrate palate. rich tannins give structure to the wine.

## RHONE

- COTES DU RHONE Belleruche, 2007** £10.60  
Deep ruby colour with aromas of blackberries, cherries and earth. This is medium bodied with silky tannins and plenty of luscious fruit.
- GIGONDAS 2003/2004, E. Guigal** £19.20  
Reflecting the Guigal trademark of fullness and depth, this is a big, chunky red, laden with intense berry fruits.

**ITALY :** - **CHIANTI CLASSICO, San Leonino, 2006, Tenimenti Angelini** £13.10  
Traditionally styled Chianti with violet and red cherry characters, vibrant acidity and sweet spice on the finish.

**SPANISH :** - **RIOJA RESERVA 2004 , Marques de Riscal** £17.50  
A classic Rioja with complex aromas of vanilla and toasted oak combined with summer fruit flavours.

**AUSTRALIA :** - **TATACHILLA Foundation Shiraz, 2003, Mc Laren Vale** £14.80  
Rich, plummy fruit, with underlying layers of blackcurrant, raspberry, coffee, spicy oak and fine tannins culminate in a sophisticated structure.

**CHILEAN :** - **SANTA RITA RESERVA Merlot 2007** £9.40  
This smooth, velvety wine shows rich plum fruit flavours, hints of Chocolate and Vanilla, balanced by soft, well integrated tannins.

### ROSE WINE

**FRANCE :** - **CHATEAU SAINT ROCH-LES-VIGNES 2007/08 Provence** £8.90  
A delicious rosé showing soft spice and attractive fruit from this top winery in St Tropez.

### ORGANIC WINE

**WHITE :** - **BONTERRA VINEYARDS 2007, Chardonnay** £12.50  
A well balanced Chardonnay with subtle nuances of vanilla oak, crisp acidity and a full rich flavour.

**RED :** - **BONTERRA VINEYARDS ZINFANDEL 2006** £13.20  
This formidable Zinfandel is a rich black cherry, scented wine with a lovely spicy finish.
